High Level Requirements

Global – on each webpage within the ZEIT website, there will be a header that has the top navigation panel and there will be a footer.

1. **Homepage** – where site visitors are introduced to the KCRCI organization
2. **About Page** – where site visitors can find a brief history of KCRCI, KCRCI's mission and members of the KCRCI organization
3. **What's CKD/Need? Page** – where site visitors can learn more about CKD and the need to address CKD, kidney functions and dialysis.
4. **Products and Services Page** – where site visitors can learn about the products and services KCRCI offers
5. **Clinics Page** – where site visitors can see pictures and details of each KCRCI affiliated clinic
6. **Contact Page** – where site visitors can send an messages to KCRCI team members
7. **Donate Page** – where site visitors can make monetary donations to KCRCI

- Information of Kidney function
- Information of Treatment Options: Hemodialysis, Peritoneal Dialysis & Transplantation
- CTA button linked to donation page

- List of products KCRCI offers
- Description of products KCRCI offers
- CTA button to linked to Contact Page

Clinics Page

- Carousel view of KCRCI's clinics with clinic description and images
- CTA button linked to donation page

Contact Page

- Contact form for visitors to fill out to contact KCRCI team members
- CTA button linked to KCRCI email

Log In Page

- Contact form for visitors to fill out information for monetary donation
- CTA button linked to KCRCI account to receive donations
